School Self - Evaluation

As part of our ongoing S.S.E., the following are the areas of focus for the school year.

Literacy: Written Presentation We are working hard towards developing written presentation from junior infants to 6th class. We are understanding that this is a skill, and like all skills, they develop at a pace unique to each child. We are using our Wonderful Writing Wall in school to show off samples of children's writing and **ALL** children will feature on the wall a number of times throughout the year. We strongly encourage all children from 3rd class to use Cursive writing in all written work, including homework.

Reading for pleasure Children are also taking part in whole school **Buddy Reading**, where children from all classes read/listen to stories for pleasure with a 'buddy'.

Numeracy Focus; Mental Maths strategy development. All children will be given a profile on IXL where they will be assigned tasks covering various Maths topics. Each teacher will receive the data for their class to analyze strengths as well as areas of difficulty.
